Whether the Halifax County Board of Commissioners should request the General Assembly to adopt local legislation as set forth in a document entitled "Proposed Local Legislation Regarding Hunting in Halifax County." The proposed legislation concerns certain limitations on hunting from the Roanoke River, hunting with dogs, and written permission to hunt, trap or fish on the lands of others.
